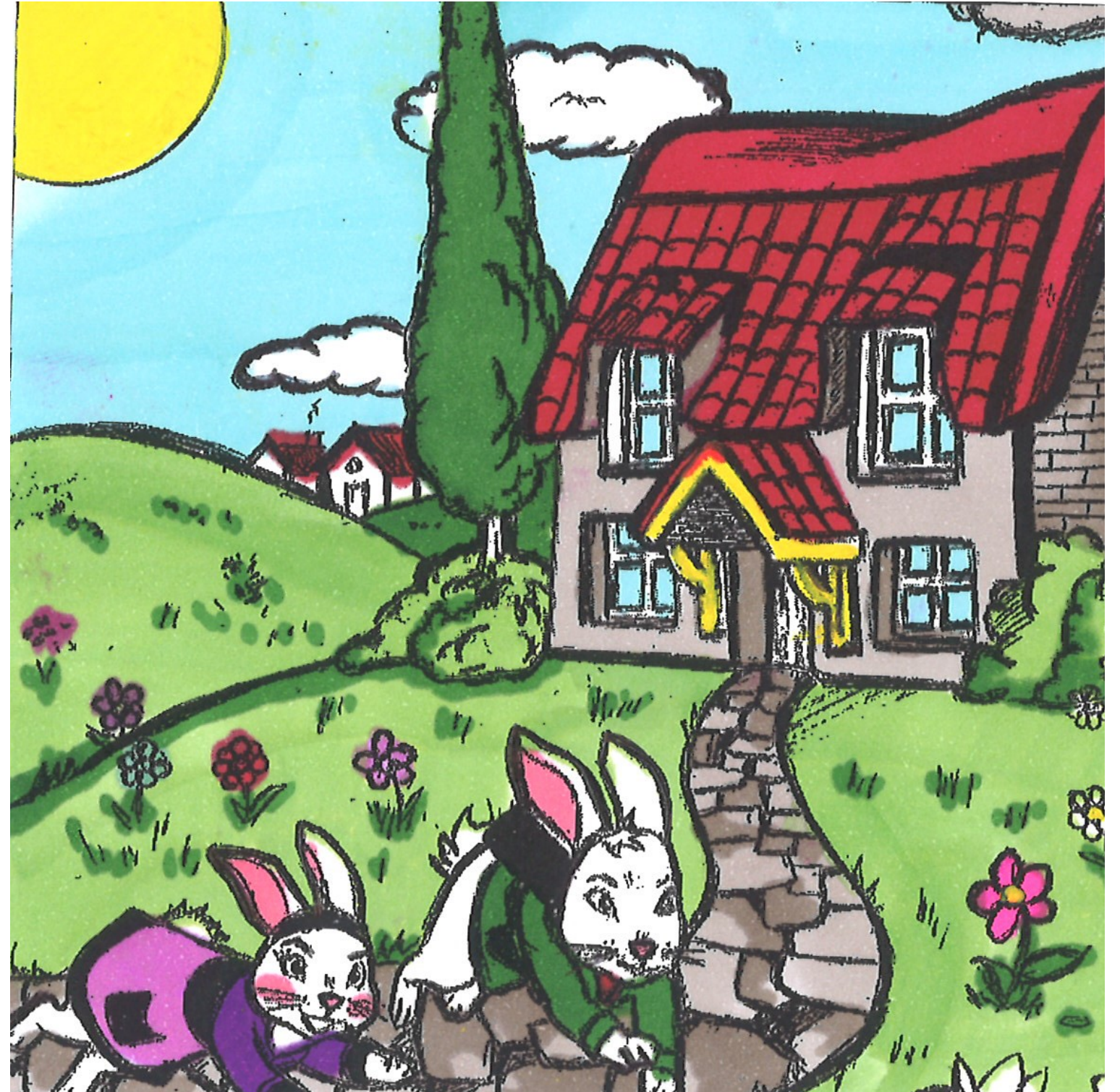
What Is The Point Of Sleep?

From that day on Jerome and Jenny loved to sleep. They knew it was magic and would help them grow up and be bright and bouncy to enjoy adventures with their friends!

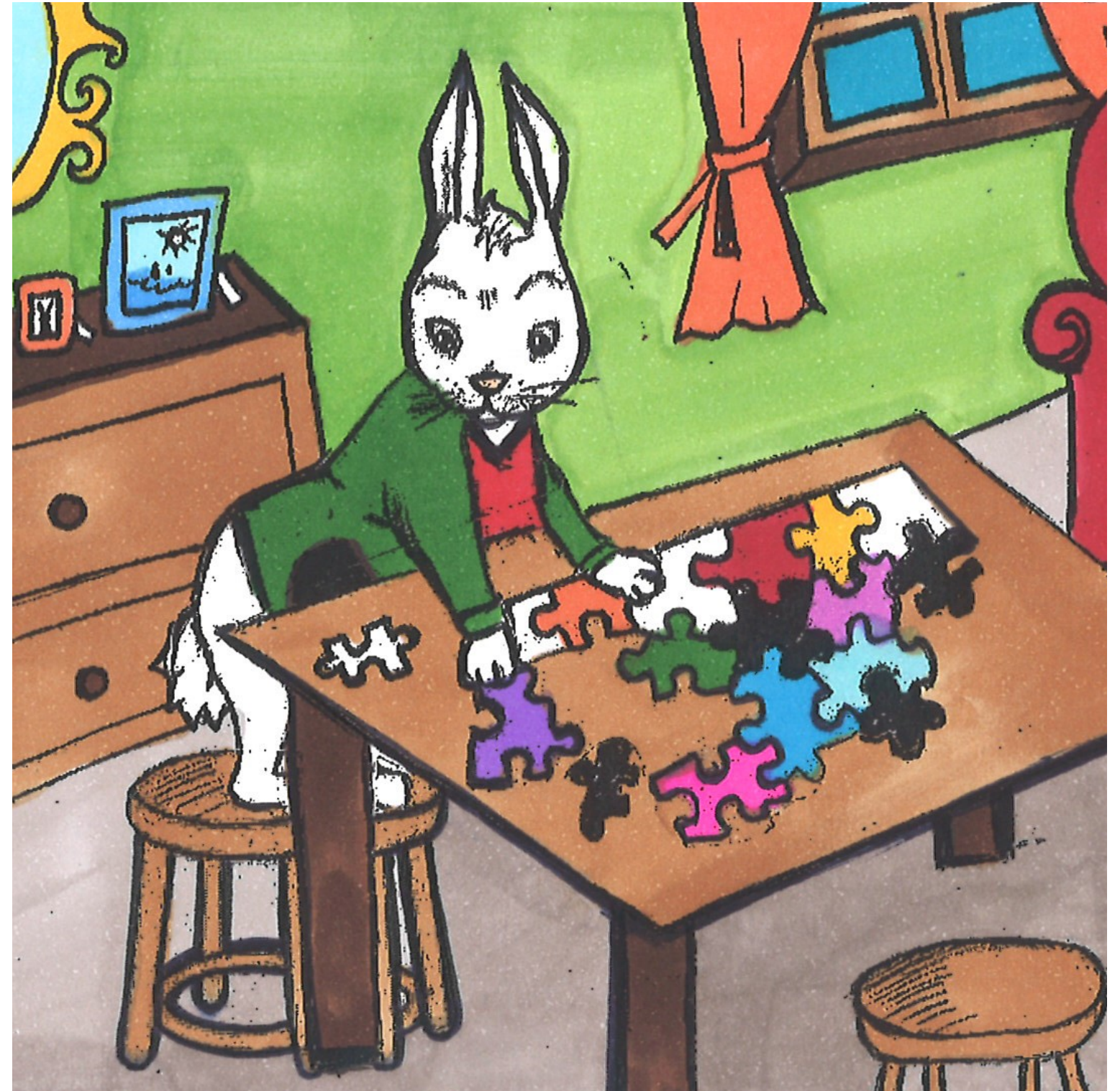


Jerome adored jigsaw puzzles.

puzzles he could find in the house!



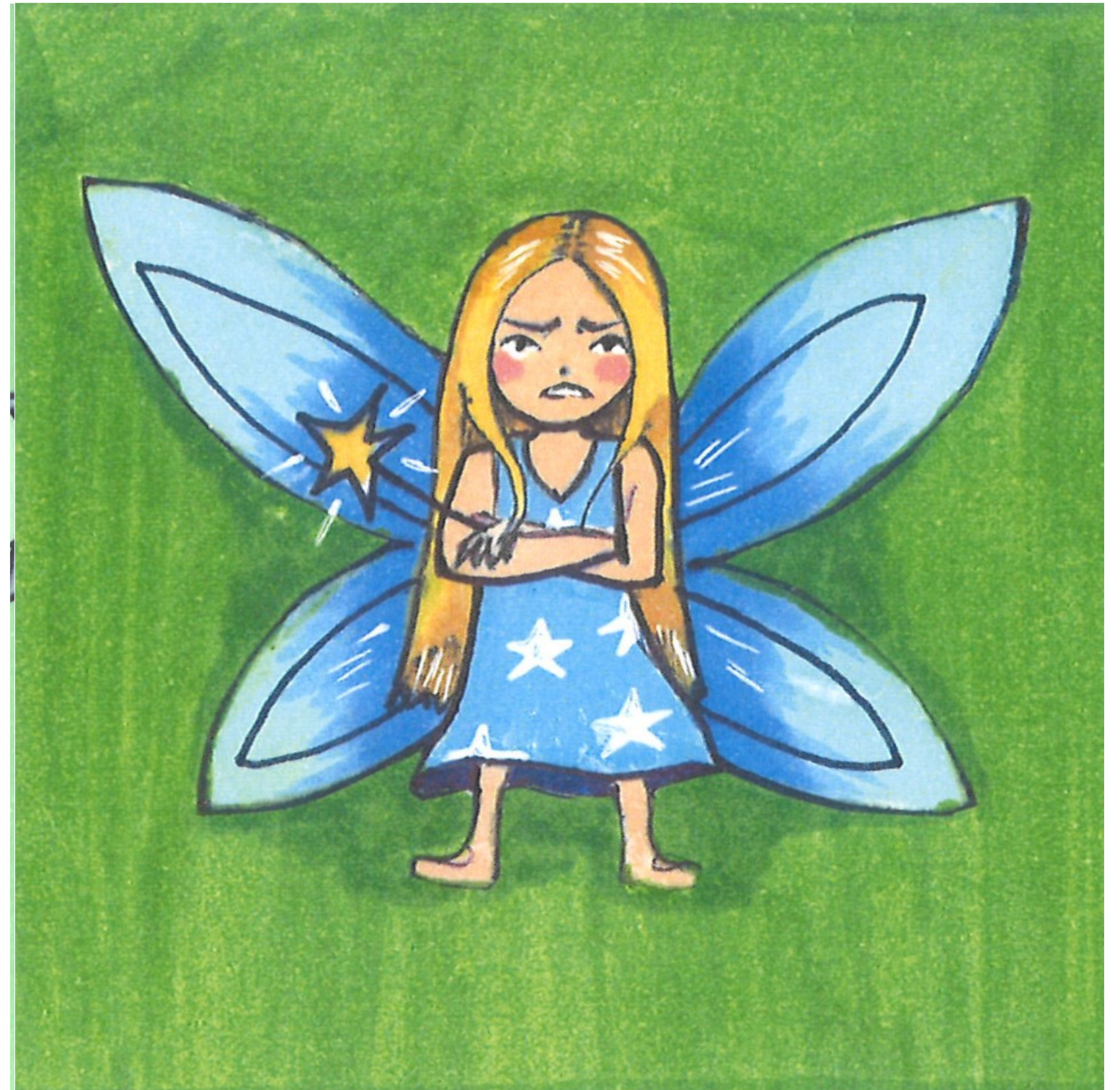
You are not remembering your lessons from school, you are getting ill and you are too grumpy to play with your friends!"

"Promise me you'll sleep at night so that I can watch you having fun in the day!"



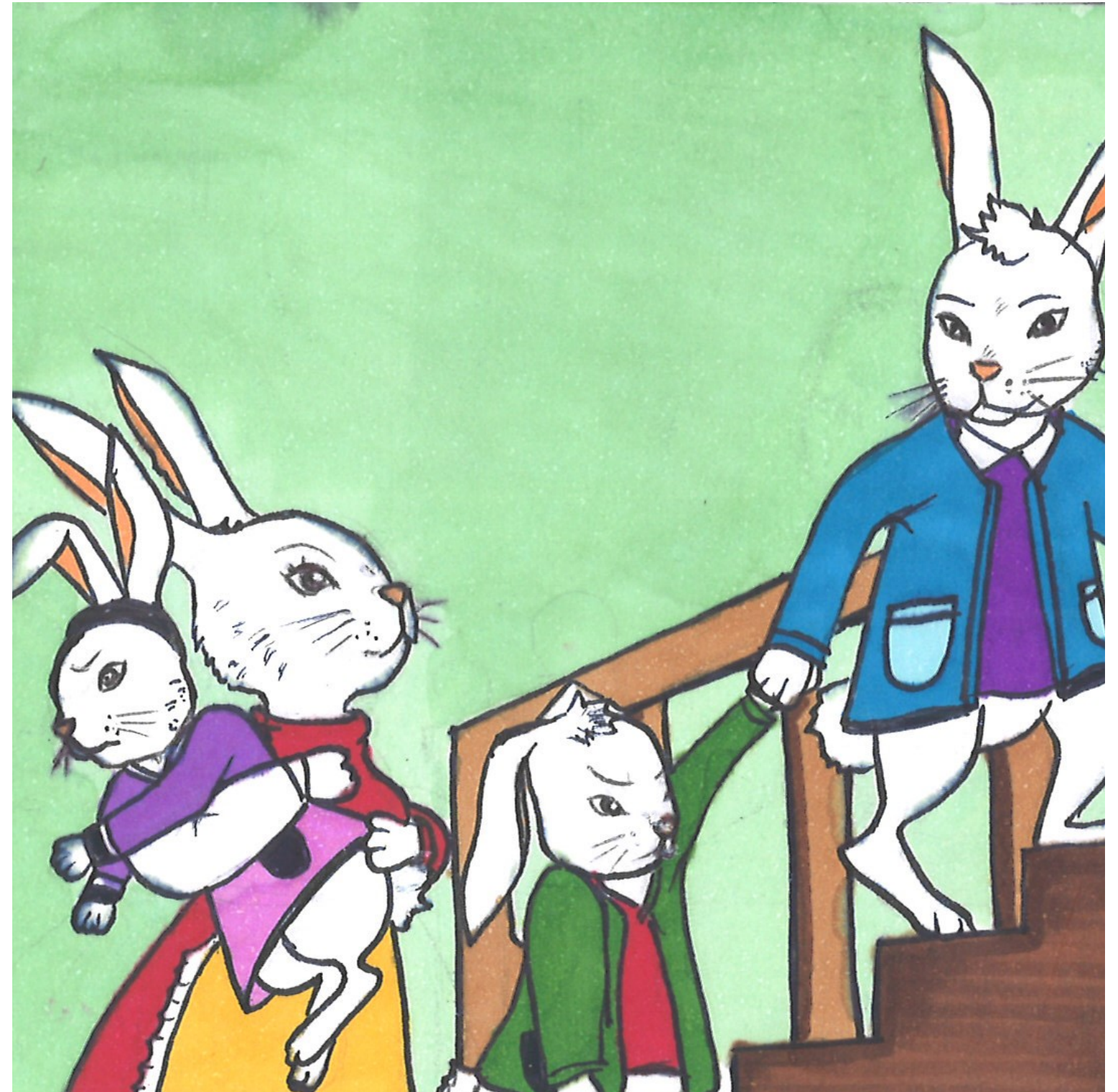
When it was bedtime, Mummy and

shout.



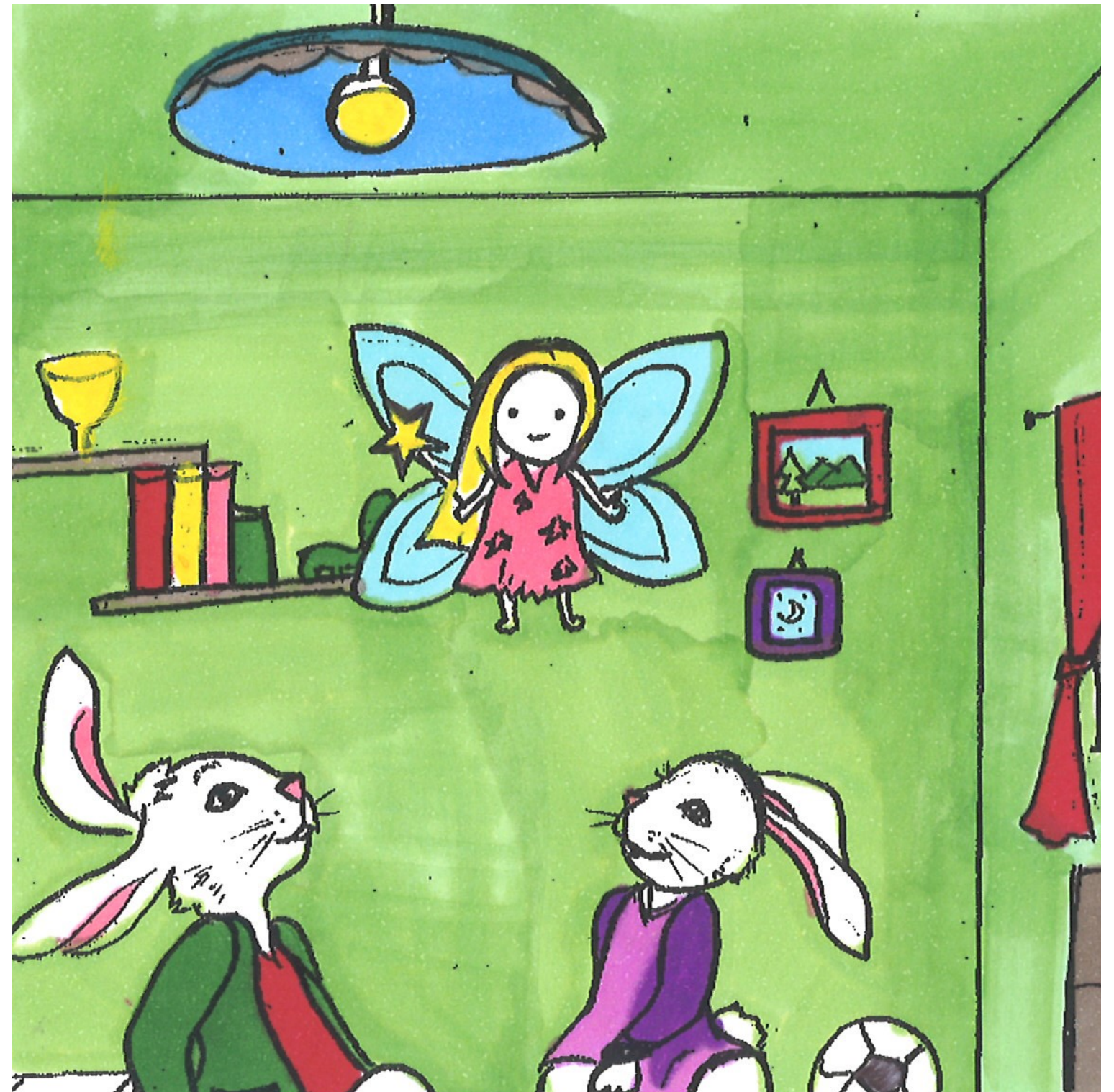
"Children, children, children.. I am

hand!"



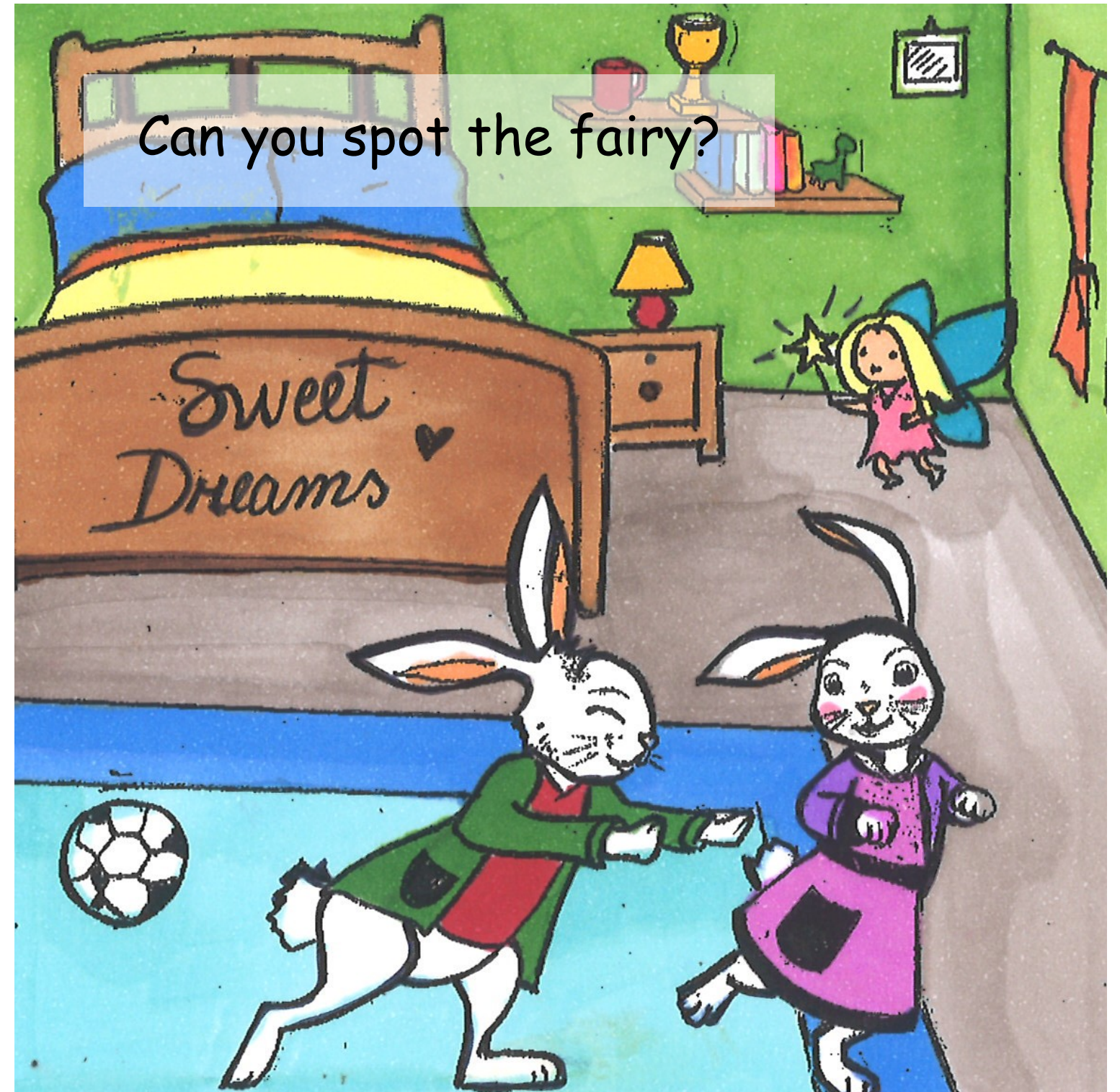
Every night once Mummy and Daddy

to winter.

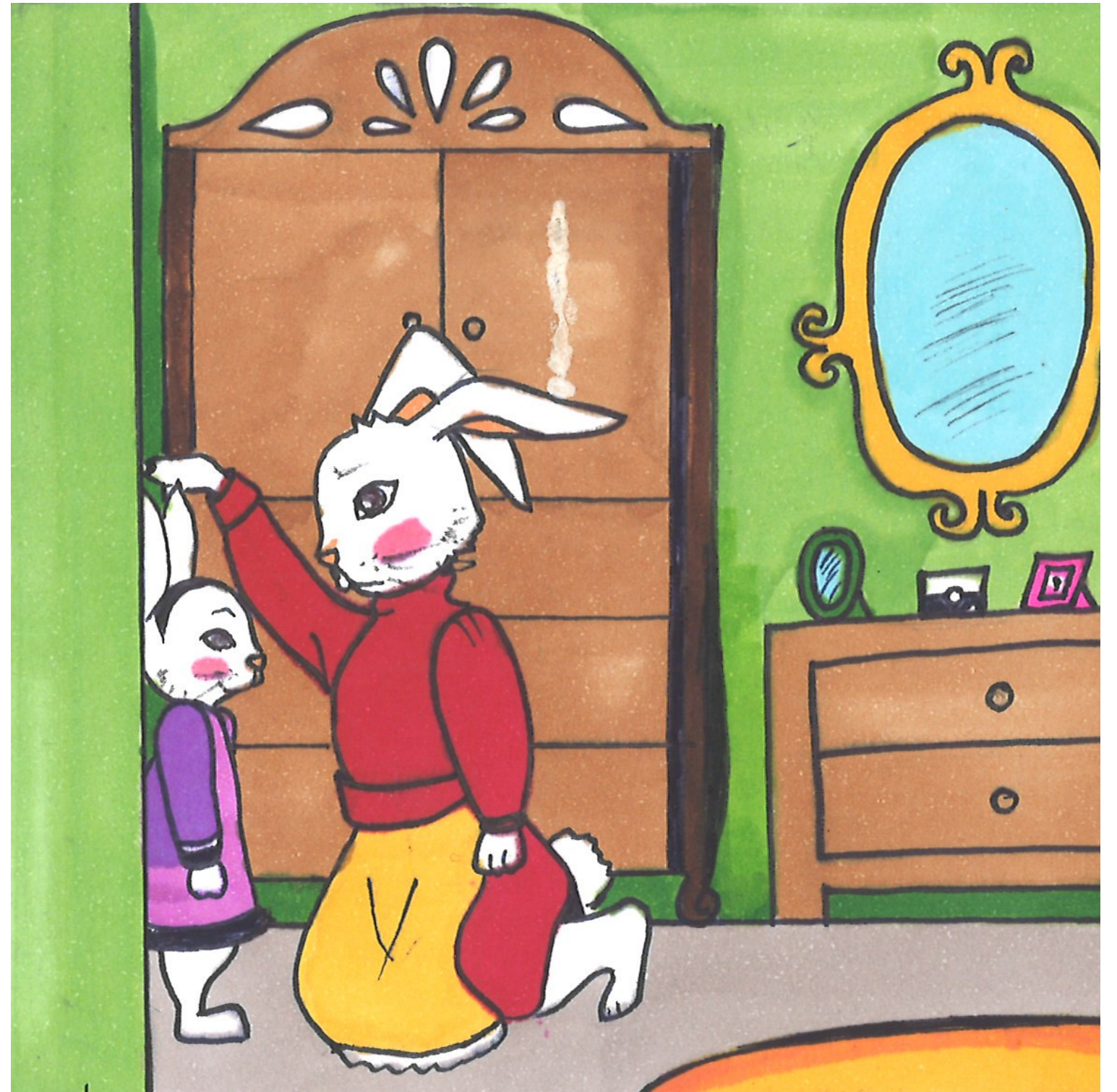
After a while they noticed some
strange things



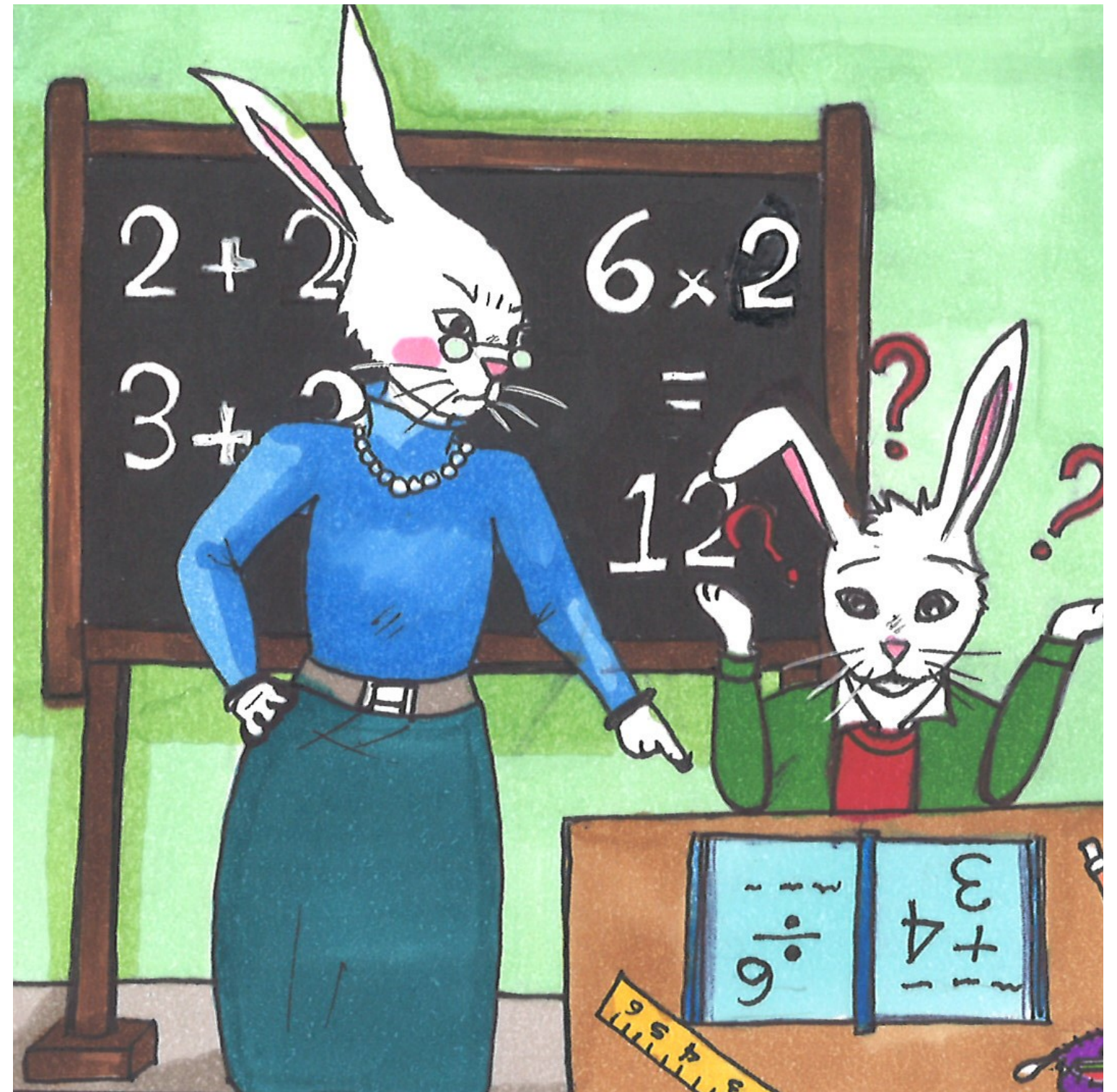
Finally, Jerome was so tired that his body couldn't fight off nasty bugs, so he was in bed for a **WHOLE** day feeling poorly!
