## Continence Tier Levels

Below outlines service descriptions and what 'good' looks like. The terms 'Level' and 'Tier' may be used interchangeably in other documents and within local services.

Tier 1

 All universal healthcare services. This includes general practitioners, practice nurses, children's community nurses, health visitors and school nurses.

Tier 2

• Specialist services in the community. Refering to the integrated community children's bladder and bowel service.

Tier 3

• Services provided by secondary or tertiary care. These include paediatricians, paediatric gastroenterologists and paediatric surgeons, as well as inpatient facilities and accident and emergency departments

Tier 4

• Paediatric Urologists
